



**Earth's surface is covered by land (29 per cent) and water (71 per cent).**

**The shape of the Earth:** Earth's shape is a spheroid; not quite a sphere it is flattened at the poles (the north pole and the south pole) and bulges at the equator.

**CONTINENTS:**Very large land areas are known as continents.

There are seven continents in the world:

1. Asia: Asia is the largest continent in the world. Have forty eight countries. Our country India is in Asia.
2. Africa: Africa is the second largest continent in the world. Have more countries than any other continent.
3. North America: North America is the third largest continent in the world.

4. South America: South America is the fourth largest continent in the world.
5. Antarctica: Antarctica is the fifth largest continent in the world. It is permanently covered with ice; known as white continent.
6. Europe: Europe is the world's second smallest continent.
7. Australia: Australia is the world's smallest continent. It is an island.

**OCEANS**: Very large water bodies are known as Oceans. Oceans have saline (salty) water.

There are five oceans in the world.

1. The Pacific Ocean: The Pacific Ocean is the biggest ocean in the world. The deepest point on the Earth 'The Mariana Trench', is in the Pacific Ocean.
2. The Atlantic Ocean : The Atlantic Ocean is the second largest ocean in the world.
3. The Indian Ocean : The Indian Ocean is the third largest ocean in the world.
4. The Arctic Ocean : The Arctic Ocean is the smallest ocean in the world.
5. The Southern Ocean: The Southern Ocean came to be recognized in the year 2000. It is the fourth largest ocean in the world.
  - *Country* :Smaller divisions of continents are known as countries.
  - *Seas* : Smaller (than oceans) areas of water are known as seas.
  - *Island* : An island is a piece of land surrounded by water.
  - *Archipelago* : A group of islands close together are known as archipelago.


