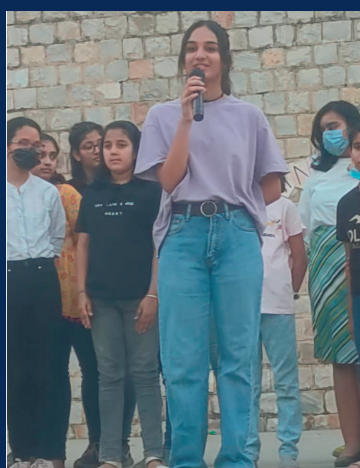

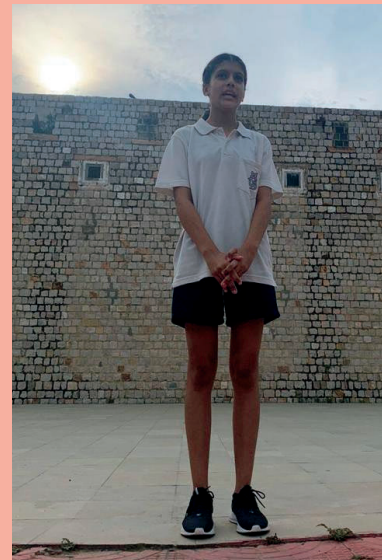
Talent Hunt

Quint Hurdle

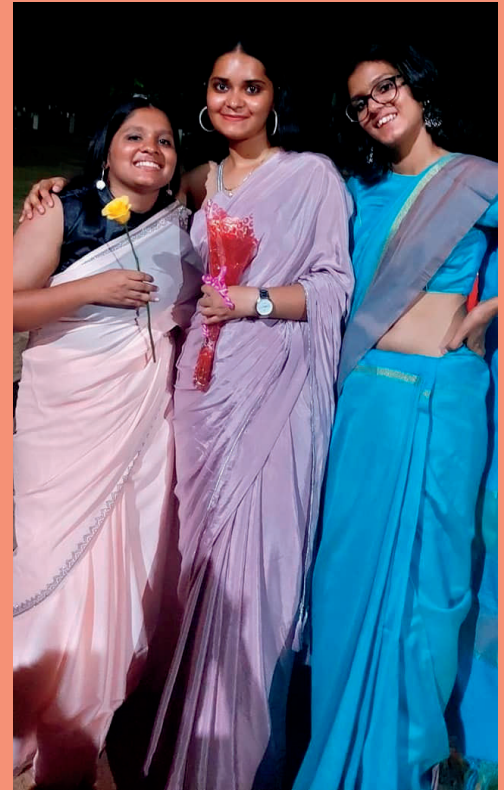

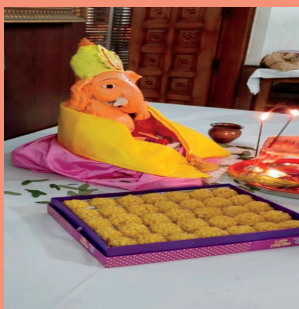
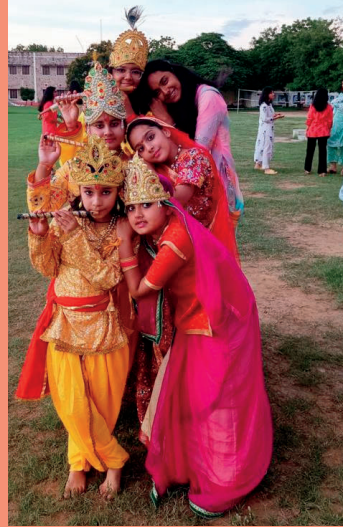
11th August Rangoli Making

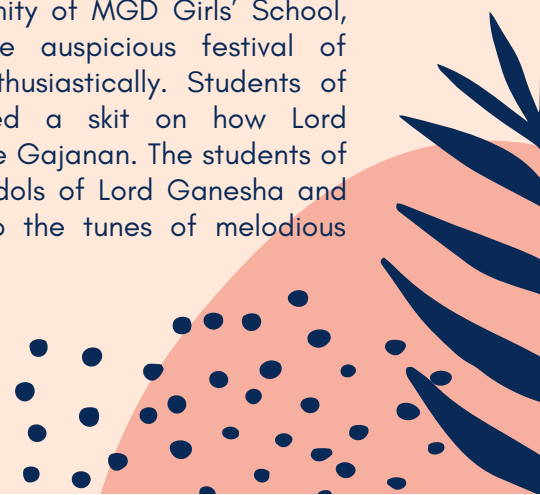
19th August Janmashtami Celebrations

यहाँ तक पहुँचाया है।

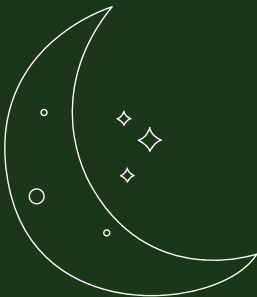

It feels like a tornado

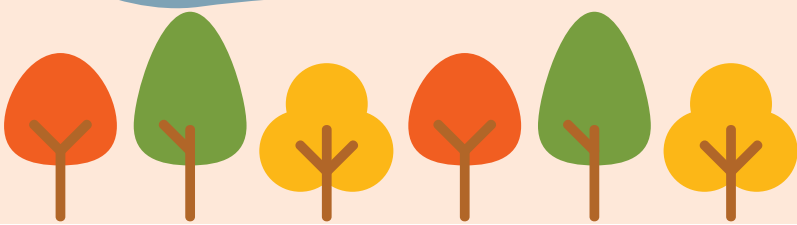
It feels like an earthquake in the ocean,

The more you scream the more you drown

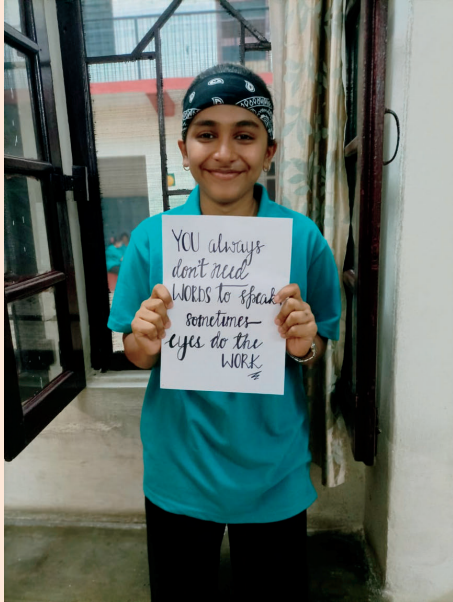
Irs just you and blue blank water, nothing
