From Nagaland:

- Use Naga tribal patterns (geometric, zigzag) to decorate the layout.
- Add bamboo huts or hornbill motif in the scenery.
- Illustrate a Naga cultural festival, such as Hornbill Festival, as the fair background.

What to do?








