What to do:

Encourage your child to speak magic words like 'Thank you', 'Please', 'Excuse me' and 'Sorry.'

Social development

Encourage your child to converse freely with parents and siblings.

Guide the child to keep his/her toys and belongings back in their place.

Encourage him/her to make his/her own cold cereal.

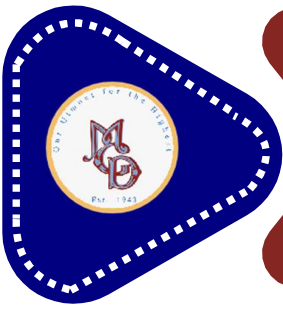

- **Materials:** Use materials like dried beans, rice, or sand in a container.

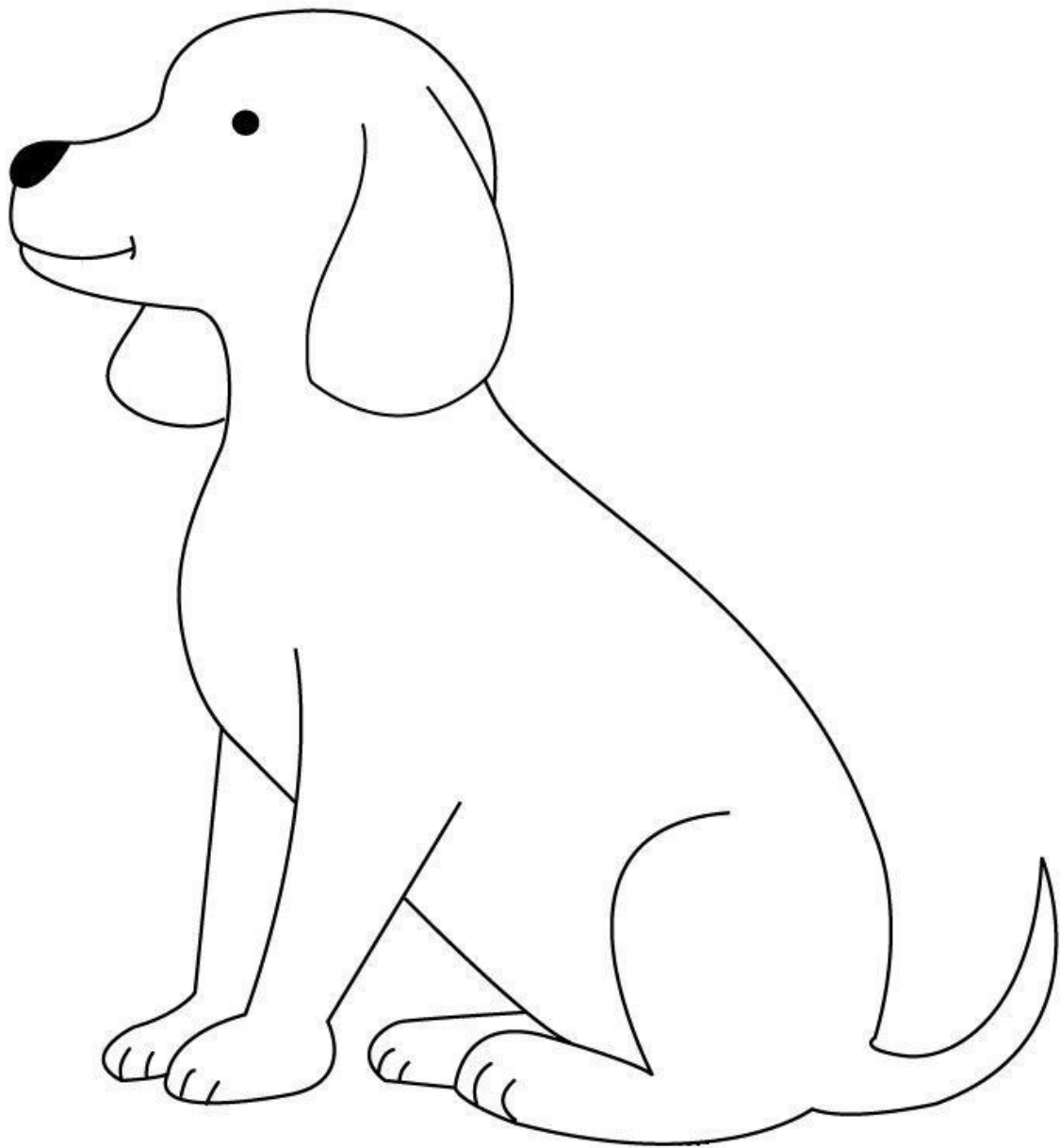

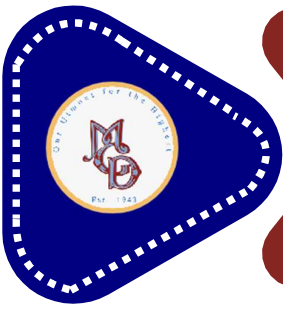
- **Creating a family tree craft is a wonderful way to celebrate your heritage! Here's how you can do it:**

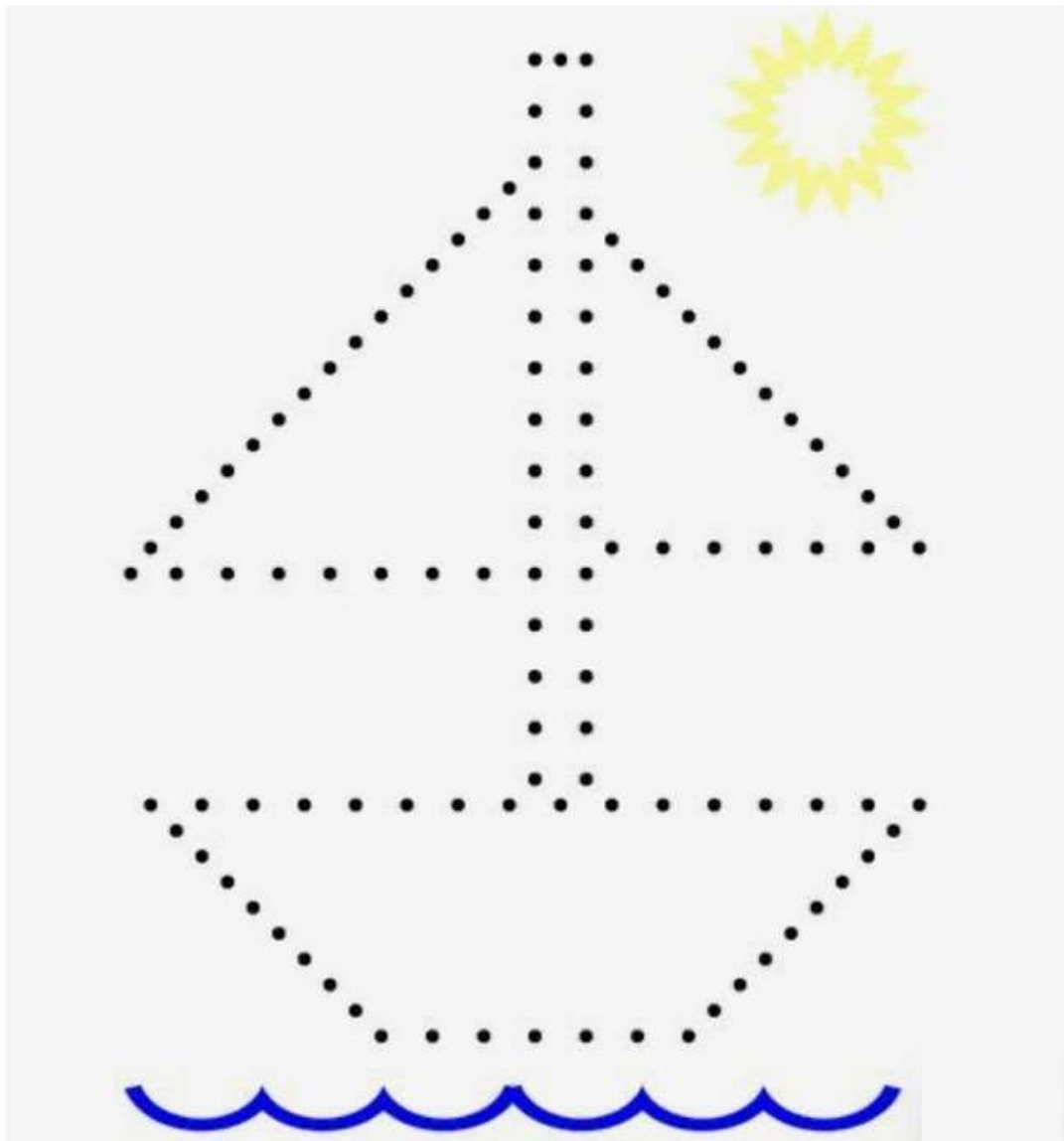

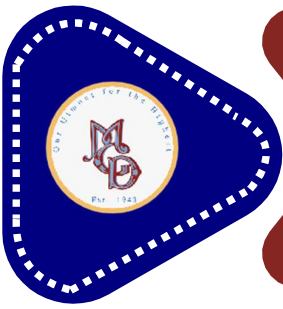




Use colourful popsicle sticks to complete the boat

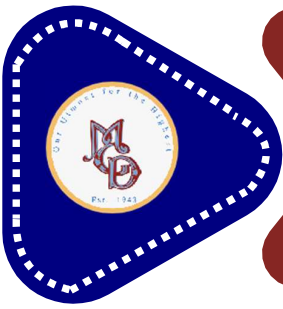

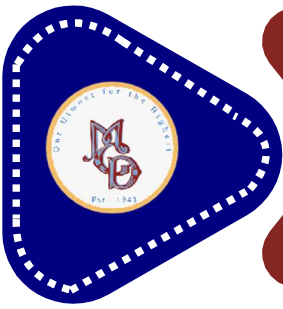




Trace the left slanting lines

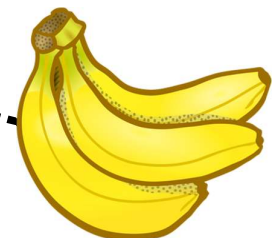
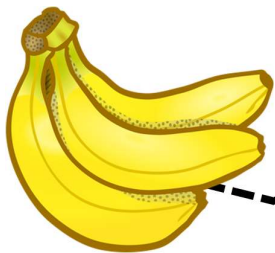
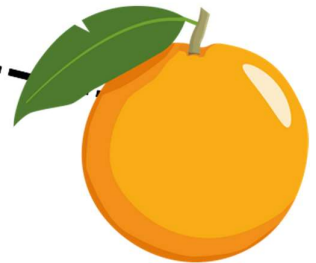
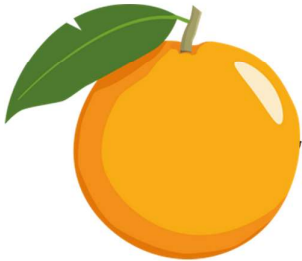
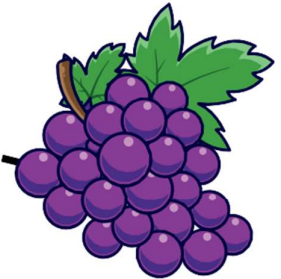
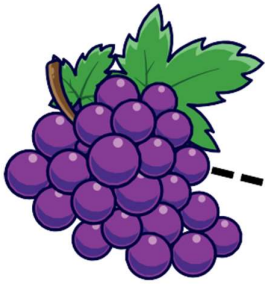
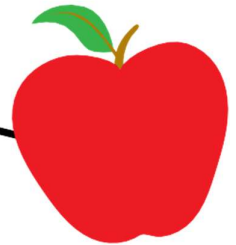
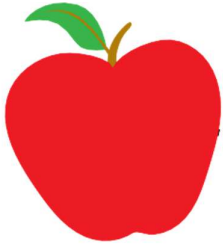

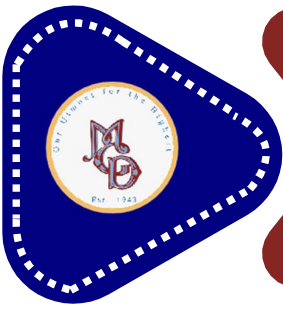




Trace the right slanting lines

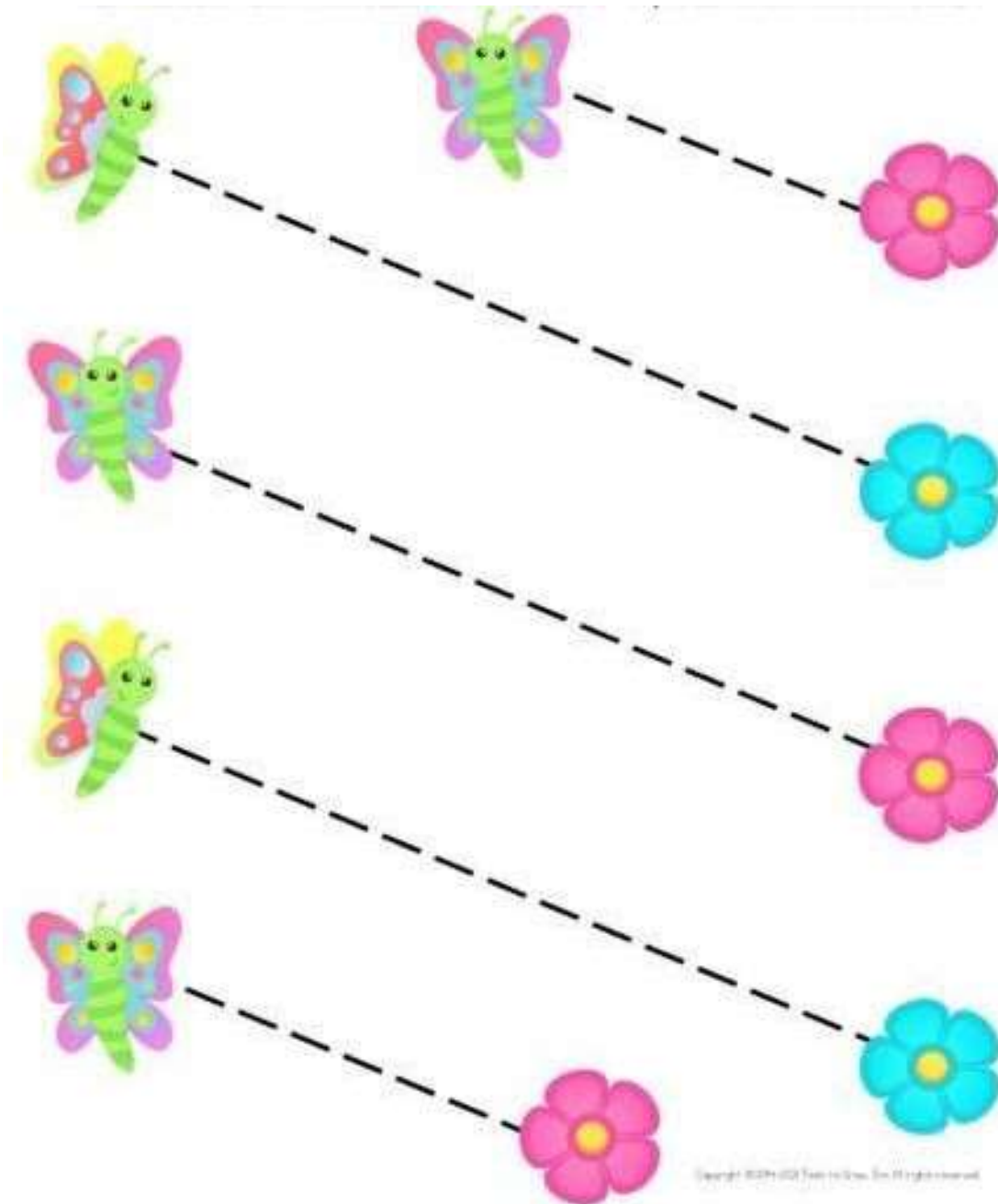
